

# Council of Arroyo Seco Organizations

The regular meeting of the Council of Arroyo Seco Organizations took place at the Flintridge Center at 236 West Mountain Street, Pasadena, CA 91103. The representatives of CASO groups started gathering at 6:30 pm to partake of light refreshments and network about Arroyo Seco issues and activities.

Tim Brick chaired the event and began the formal business meeting at 7:15 pm.

Discussion topics covered different aspects of Hahamongna:

- Los Angeles County Flood Control District's Devil's Gate Dam Sediment Removal and Management Plan
- Pasadena's Hahamongna Multi-Use/Multi-Benefit plan which includes
  - Sycamore Grove Multi-Purpose Field;
  - Westside Perimeter Trail;
  - Restoration of Berkshire Creek;
  - Oak Grove Field Restroom;
  - Foothill Drain Improvements;
  - Expanded Parking Area;
  - and Habitat Restoration
- The public involvement in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) process of the MB/MU project including:
  - Making thorough and intelligent comments on the Initial Study for the Supplemental environmental Impact Report. Where to get information for making comments and how to formulate the comments.
  - Getting active in the Pasadena City Council. Making public statements at Council Meetings.
- The expansion of the Save Hahamongna campaign to include multiple organizations, such as the Pasadena Audubon Society.
- The removal of the existing JPL parking lot and construction of a multi-level parking facility.
