MOVE AHEAD WITH CONFLUENCE PARK

The Arroyo Seco Confluence has the potential to be the gem of Los Angeles River Revitalization.

We were hopeful that the rehabilitation of the Riverside Drive Bridge over the Confluence would be a major step forward in the development of the Arroyo Seco Confluence Park. The tree storage yard adjacent to the Confluence was moved to make way for the construction project. We recently learned, however, that the City of Los Angeles now intends to bring the tree storage yard back to that site after the bridge construction project is completed. This would constitute a major delay and obstacle towards the development of Confluence Park and be a big disappointment to those who have waited patiently to see Confluence Park take shape.

Before you leave office, we urge you to find another location for the tree storage yard and begin implementing Confluence Park as a key element of Los Angeles River Revitalization.
