

Rose Bowl Parking and Directions

Getting there

Spectators are urged to arrive at least two hours before game time because heavy traffic is expected. **Stadium gates will open at 2:30 p.m.** Seats are sold out.

No motor homes, campers or recreational vehicles will be allowed to park in the lots adjacent to the Rose Bowl.

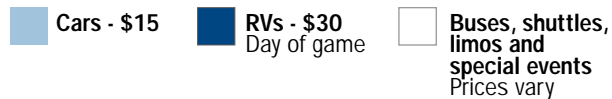
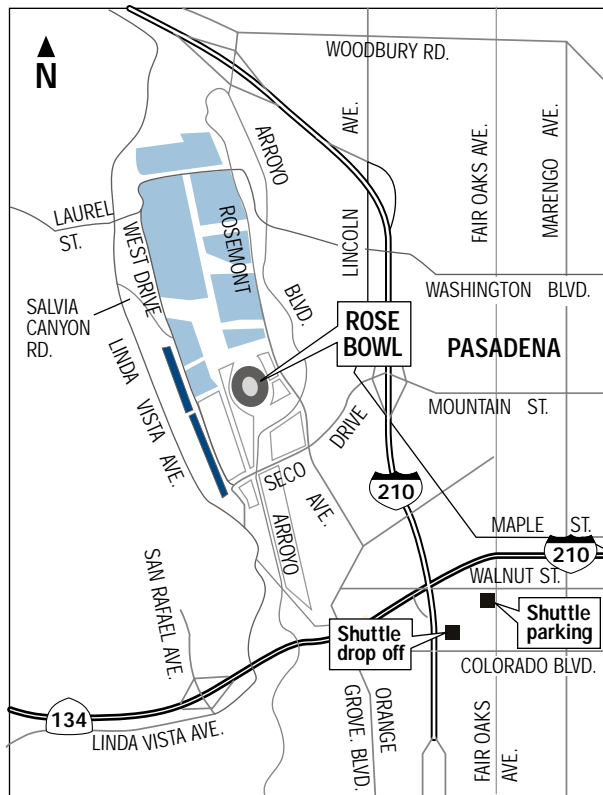
From the north or east: Exit the Foothill Freeway (210) at Berkshire-Oak Grove, Arroyo-Windsor, Lincoln or Mountain-Seco.

From the south: Take Golden State Freeway (5) northbound to Glendale Freeway (2) northbound to Foothill Freeway (210) eastbound. Exit at the offramps listed above.

From the west: Take Ventura Freeway (134) eastbound to Foothill Freeway (210) westbound. Exit at offramps listed above.

Parking: All Rose Bowl parking lots will be open at 8 a.m. Cars will be parked bumper-to-bumper so it will take some time to leave.

Free shuttle service: Runs every five minutes (see map) from 1 p.m. until one hour after the game. Parking is \$20 for cars, \$100 for RVs. Use Fair Oaks Ave. exit off the 210.



At the Stadium

First Aid
 Located on the concourse opposite Tunnel 27.

Security Headquarters
 Located on the street-level concourse opposite Tunnel 1. This is also the location for Lost and Found.

Concessions
 Located immediately in front of tunnel entrances.

Restrooms
 Located immediately in front of tunnel entrances.

Telephones
 Located adjacent to Tunnels 1, 4, 9, 14, 18 and 26.
